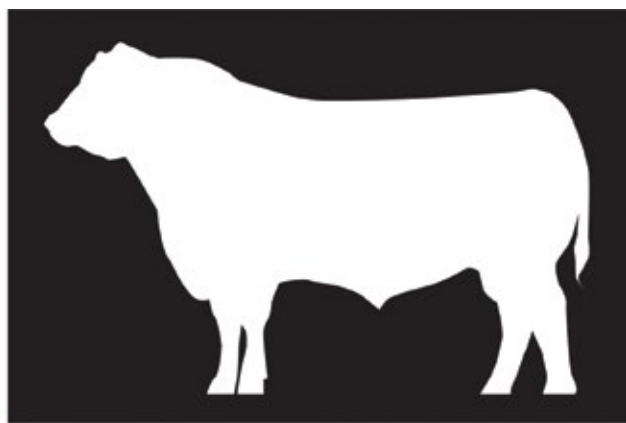

She has a wonderful temperament, is structurally correct and has longevity on her side. Her dam N590 is fertile, has a good constitution and has just calved again as an 11-year-old cow. Her grand dam Autumn 15 was under 12 months heifer champion at the Charolais National show in 2016.

WELCOME

We are pleased to welcome you to the Twenty First Annual Wakefield Sale.

It seems like no time since our first sale at the showgrounds in Armidale – how time flies. It has been fabulous to meet so many people over the years and see the Wakefield herd grow into one of the larger Charolais herds in Australia and a smaller industry focused Angus herd.

This has been a year of two halves with a very wet lead up to Christmas and then very limited rainfall up until the start of May when there has been good general rain across the majority of NSW. Large numbers of cattle have been sold from the Northern and Southern Tablelands and Western areas including many breeding cattle. With the late break before winter many producers were not prepared to hold cattle and feed them particularly with a Spring El Nino predicted. The cattle prices held up remarkably well under intense selling pressure and have rebounded to almost record levels. Depending on what happens in the Spring we are going to see strong restocker demand and I think we can look forward to some very healthy prices in the next 12 months. We have all been through El Nino events before and it doesn't always mean below average rainfall.

We planted about 250 acres of annual and perennial rye in late February and about 90% germinated from moisture retained and then had no more rainfall until May. We can't believe that it survived and were sure it was a failure but since the May rainfall it has done very well and is now running a lot of cattle. Unfortunately, it came a little bit too late for the sale bulls and we have brought the Charolais bulls home and have prepared them for the sale with unlimited access to barley hay and grain assistance. We are continuing to catch up on repairs and replacement of fences and a big thank you to Darren, Tash and family who have been with us for 2 years now. It has made a big difference to have a hand with all the jobs and there is light at the end of the tunnel albeit still a bit distant!

It was a pleasure to attend and once again sponsor the Grafton weaner sales and have a chance to see an outstanding line up of young cattle. For the first time this year we also sponsored the Ramsay Bulmer weaner sale at Casino and would like to welcome them as an agent into our sale. Congratulations to the

vendors on the quality of the cattle on display. The most noticeable feature from the sales we attended was the premium that the Charolais infused weaners attracted over their British counterparts. This was mostly being driven by demand from Queensland for cattle that are suitable for their environment, but also solid enquiry from Western NSW producers for cattle with high growth and the ability to hit target markets quickly.

Chris and Lucy continue to be very busy with 2 young children. Annie is a 3yr old now and a complete delight, Herb, who will turn 1 at the end of July is gearing up for his second bull sale and is becoming very mobile! Nothing better than growing up on a farm! They continue to improve their farm at Dorrigo and are busy running both farm stays as well as leasing about 3000 acres including part of Wakefield.

Our youngest daughter Claire continues doing two days a week at a local Armidale practice and an increasing amount of local vet work. She is enjoying her house at Chandler and has Twiggy the whippet as a house mate. Twiggy spends a bit of time at Wakefield as well and has put the wind up the local hare population here. The new clinic has finally cleared all the hurdles with the Local Council and has had the DA approved. The modifications to satisfy the council are under way including disabled toilet facilities and disabled access.

We are very grateful to our family for everything they do for us and proud that they see a future in agriculture. We are extremely confident that the farms will be in very capable hands when Jenny and I want to step back.

Over the last 12 months, once again, there have been many outstanding results in feedlots, sales, abattoirs, showrings and stud bull auctions from stock sired by Wakefield bulls. We have a small show team going to the Ekka this year to coincide with Charolais being the feature breed and Charolais World Congress being held in Australia. Wakefield Whizz Bang had his first outing at The Sydney Royal and it was humbling to have him receive Reserve Junior Champion bull at just 10 months of age.

It is very pleasing to see such great recognition of the Wakefield brand and the progeny receiving strong demand from buyers. The overwhelming comments have been how well the bulls are performing under tough conditions, their longevity, and the market suitability of their progeny. We would like to thank our bull buyers for their loyalty to our program.

The Wakefield bull breeding program is tailored to produce calves which will fit the specifications of a wide range of markets and remember we are a commercial operation as well and have a good understanding of what is required. We appreciate feedback from our clients on how our bulls are performing as it helps us to make more informed breeding decisions. Wakefield has one of the most genetically diverse herds recorded, particularly in the Charolais, as a result of our emphasis on targeting proven female lines. We have introduced embryos from a range of herds and maintain cow lines we have identified as breed leaders. There is no doubt in our mind that to breed good bulls it is critical to have a lot of depth in the cow herd and we are not afraid to use older genetics if they have the runs on the board.

Our emphasis is on breeding tough cattle that are at the top of the breed for dollars earned. The bulls this year have been prepared on pasture grass paddocks with unlimited access to hay and grain assistance. They will present in a forward, but not fat condition and we are very happy with the way they are shaping up. We are not one of the breeders whose bulls are the best you will ever see them on sale day! We think this is critical to the longevity of the bull and his ability to hold condition under tougher conditions. Quite a few of our bulls are jumped directly off the truck straight into client's cow herds!

We look forward to seeing you on Friday the 14th of August at our "all weather" sale complex. Complimentary lunch will be available prior to the sale, which commences at 1pm. This year we celebrate 166 years of continuous cattle breeding as Wakefield has been held in the same family since 1860.

Wakefield began breeding Charolais in 1970 when the breed was first introduced into Australia and used most of the early French bulls in grading up programs until currently a herd of 550 Charolais and Angus females are maintained.

Through the years there have been selected introductions of stud Charolais females, purchase of embryos, regular artificial insemination and embryo transfer programs.

We have been breeding Angus for our composite program for many years and for the last 18 years have been building our registered Angus herd. In combination with upgrading existing cows to APR status, large scale artificial insemination/ embryo transfer programs and introduction of industry leading embryos the Angus herd is growing rapidly.

Our emphasis is to produce bulls to increase profit in our client's herds and the calves born over the next few years will be sired by a smaller number of select sires.

We think that Canadian, French and Australian Charolais sires provide the balance of growth and carcass characteristics we require. Angus sires are being sourced from the US and Australia.

Wakefield was amongst the pioneers in the use of Charolais Composite bulls and it is pleasing to see Charolais being recognised as the "breed of choice" in crossbreeding programs. We have decided to concentrate more on our purebred lines as they seem to provide more uniformity in their progeny and keep breeding programs simpler for our clients. A lot of herds have used composite bulls as a stepping stone into the Charolais breed and have quickly realised the financial benefits of crossbreeding.

Our aim across both breeds is good calving ease while maintaining growth and breed specific carcass characteristics. Wakefield is a Group Breedplan member so EBVs are available on all purebred bulls and our herd is based around selecting for commercially important traits, such as yield, growth and feed efficiency.

We are bull breeders not bull feeders. Structural correctness is very important to us and we like to have feedback from our clients to make sure the bulls are performing well under all conditions.

We are proud of our sale bulls and can recommend them to you as herd improvers. They can be purchased in the knowledge that they will perform well under commercial conditions and are fully guaranteed.

REFRESHMENTS - Complimentary lunch and refreshments will be provided by Wakefield.

INSPECTION - Inspection can be made prior to sale day by appointment with the agents or the vendors. Bulls will be available for inspection on sale day from 10am.

ANGUS BULLS - The Angus bulls will be sold via a Helmsman system this year which will open at 11.30 on Sale day and will close 1 hour after the Charolais auction finishes in the ring or when there has been no bid received for 10 minutes.

UNABLE TO ATTEND - Online bidding and live streaming with StockLive using a Starlink connection will be available throughout the sale. Over the phone bidding by arrangement with the agents or vendors is also available and private inspections are welcomed and encouraged at any time prior to the sale.

GUARANTEE - In the unlikely event of infertility, provided it is not caused by injury, stress or disease contracted post sale, we will endeavour to supply a satisfactory replacement if available or issue a credit to equal the purchase price minus the salvage value to be used at future Wakefield sales. The purchaser will provide a veterinarian's certificate within six months of the purchase date.

TRANSPORT - Carriers will be in attendance at the sale. We take a keen interest in arranging the most favourable transport for your purchases. This year we are offering free freight from Wakefield to Grafton, Casino, Walcha, Armidale, Kempsey and Lismore saleyards, with the carrier of our choice. Delivery arrangements are to be made in writing on the buyers instruction form provided in the back of this catalogue.

STUD TRANSFERS - All registered animals are eligible for transfer. For transfer of animals purchasers must be members of the relevant breed society.

REBATE - 2% rebate available to outside agents accompanying potential purchasers and settling for purchases within 7 days of receipt of invoice.

NOTICE TO BUYERS - All lots will be sold subject to the usual terms and conditions governing auction sales. Phone service is available at sale complex. Please contact the vendors or your preferred agent on sale day to arrange phone hook-up. This year's sale is also interfaced with Stocklive.

CARING FOR YOUR BULL

This year's sale bulls range from 14 - 26 months of age and will need to be managed accordingly.

There are many advantages in buying younger bulls. You see the bull closer to the weights you are likely to be marketing your finished cattle at. You will get an extra year of use from your bull and most importantly you are getting the 'pick of the crop'. In our experience the best bulls will be good at all stages of growth and not only when they are mature. You can be confident that a young bull with eye appeal will only get better!

But younger bulls are still growing quickly and need enough feed to maintain their growth pattern while settling your cows. Younger bulls can be introduced into paddocks with older bulls but remember he will be on the bottom of the pecking order and will need room to avoid the others. His nutritional requirements will be greater than a mature bull so make sure he has adequate feed.

Our bulls are used to running in a mob and will arrive in a strange environment at the purchaser's property. Unload him and if possible make sure he has a steer or cow as a companion straight away.

Our cattle are mustered on motorbikes and are handled gently but firmly. They may need to be introduced to horses. The bulls have been trained to respect electric fencing.

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UNDERSTANDING ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES (EBVS)

Charolais BREEDPLAN EBV Explanations

An animal's breeding value is its genetic merit, half of which will be passed on to its progeny. While we will never know the exact breeding value, for performance traits it is possible to make good estimates. These estimates are called Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs).

In the calculation of EBVs, the performance of individual animals within a contemporary group is directly compared to the average of other animals in that group. A contemporary group consists of animals of the same sex and age class within a herd, run under the same management conditions and treated equally. Indirect comparisons are made between animals reared in different contemporary groups, through the use of pedigree links between the groups.

EBVs are expressed in the units of measurement for each particular trait. They are shown as +ive or -ive differences between an individual animal's genetics and the genetic base to which the animal is compared. For example, a bull with an EBV of +50 kg for 600-Day Weight is estimated to have genetic merit 50 kg above a value of 0 kg. Since the breed base is set to an historical benchmark, the average EBVs of animals in each year drop has changed over time as a result of genetic progress within the breed.

The absolute value of any EBV is not critical, but rather the differences in EBVs between animals. Particular animals should be viewed as being "above or below breed average" for a particular trait.

Whilst EBVs provide the best basis for the comparison of the genetic merit of animals reared in different environments and management conditions, they can only be used to compare animals analysed within the same analysis. Consequently, Charolais BREEDPLAN EBVs cannot be validly compared with EBVs for any other breed.

Although EBVs provide an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for a range of production traits, they do not provide information for all of the traits that must be considered during selection of functional animals. In all situations, EBVs should be used in conjunction with visual assessment for other traits of importance (such as structural soundness, temperament, fertility etc). A recommended practice is to firstly select breeding stock based on EBVs and to then select from this group to ensure that the final selections are otherwise acceptable.

EBVs are published for a range of traits covering fertility, calving ease, milking ability, growth, carcass merit and docility. When using EBVs to assist in selection decisions it is important to achieve a balance between the different groups of traits and to place emphasis on those traits that are important to the particular herd, markets and environment. One of the advantages of having a comprehensive range of EBVs is that it is possible to avoid extremes in particular traits and select for animals with balanced overall performance.

Calving Ease EBVs (%) are based on calving difficulty scores, birth weights and gestation length information. More positive EBVs are favourable and indicate easier calving.

- **CE % Dir = Direct Calving Ease** - The EBV for direct calving ease indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease in purebred females calving at two years of age.

- **CE % Daughters = Daughters' Calving Ease** - The EBV for daughters' calving ease indicates how easily that sire's daughters will calve at two years of age.

Gestation Length EBV (days) is an estimate of the time from conception to the birth of the calf and is based on Artificial Insemination and hand mating records. Lower (negative) Gestation Length EBVs indicate shorter gestation length and therefore easier calving and increased growth after birth.

Birth Weight EBV (kg) is based on the measured birth weight of progeny, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

200-Day Growth EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to early ages.

400-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow Weight EBV (kg) is based on the cow weight when the calf is weighed for weaning, adjusted to 5 years of age. This EBV is an estimate of the genetic difference in cow weight at 5 years of age and is an indicator of growth at later ages and potential feed maintenance requirements of the females in the breeding herd. Steer breeders wishing to grow animals out to a larger weight may also use the Mature Cow Weight EBV.

Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200-day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her milking ability.

Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum taken between 300 and 700 days of age and adjusted to 400 days of age. This EBV is an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for scrotal size. There is also a small negative correlation with age of puberty in female progeny and therefore selection for increased scrotal size will result in reduced age at calving of female progeny.

Carcass Weight EBV (kg) is based on abattoir carcass records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcass weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm) indicates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals. Sires with relatively higher Eye Muscle Area EBVs are expected to produce better muscled and higher percentage yielding progeny at the same carcass weight than will sires with lower Eye Muscle Area EBVs.

UNDERSTANDING ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES (EBVS)

Rump Fat EBV (mm) is an indicator of the genetic differences between animals in fat depth at the p8 rump site in a standard 300kg steer carcass. Sires with low, or negative, fat EBV are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcass weight than will sires with higher EBVs.

Rib Fat EBV (mm) is an indicator of the genetic differences between animals in fat depth at the 12/13th rib site in a standard 300kg steer carcass. More positive or more negative Rib Fat EBVs may be more favourable, depending on your breeding goals relating to the finishing ability of your animals.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%) indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300kg steer carcass. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of intramuscular fat (marbling) at the 12/13th rib site in a 300 kg steer carcass. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Selection Indices

Index values are reported as EBVs, in units of relative earning capacity (\$'s) for a given market. They reflect both the short-term profit generated by a sire through the sale of his progeny, and the longer-term profit generated by his daughters in a self-replacing cow herd. A selection index combines the EBVs with economic information (costs and returns) for specific market and production systems to rank animals based on relative profit values. Note that different types of animals can give similar profit values, so consideration should be given to both the index and the component EBVs when selecting animals for a particular production system. More information is available on selecting animals using a selection index.

The Index values are derived using BreedObject technology. More information is available from the BreedObject web site.

Charolais selection indices are calculated for two standard market specifications – Domestic Terminal and Northern Maternal - and are designed to optimise profit outcomes from commercial production systems. More information is available on Charolais Selection Indices.

Domestic Terminal Index (\$) - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial herd where Charolais bulls are joined with a British breed cow base (e.g. Angus)

targeting the domestic trade. This index assumes all progeny will be marketed with steers finished in the feedlot for 90 days and weighing 450 kg (250 kg HSCW and 7 mm P8 fat depth) when marketed at 12 months. Heifers will be in the feedlot for 75 days and weigh 430 kg (230 kg HSCW and 9 mm P8 fat depth) at 12 months. In response to industry feedback, positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Northern Maternal Index (\$) - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial herd where Charolais bulls are joined with Bos indicus cows in Northern Australia targeting the grass fed Jap Ox market. Selected heifers are retained for breeding and so maternal traits are of importance. Steers target 650 kg live weight (360 kg HSCW and 12 mm P8 fat depth) and heifers 630 kg (340 kg HSCW and 14 mm P8 fat depth), at 26 months of age. In response to industry feedback; positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Accuracy

Accuracy (%) is based on the amount of performance information available on the animal and its close relatives - particularly the number of progeny analysed. Accuracy is also based on the heritability of the trait and the genetic correlations with other recorded traits. Hence accuracy indicates the "confidence level" of the EBV. The higher the accuracy value the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal or its relatives. Even though an EBV with a low accuracy may change in the future, it is still the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait. As more information becomes available, an EBV is just as likely to increase in value, as it is to decrease.

Accuracy values range from 0-99%. The following guide is given for interpreting accuracy:

- **less than 50%:** Low accuracy. EBVs are preliminary and could change substantially as more performance information becomes available.
- **50-74%:** Medium accuracy. Usually based on the animal's own records and pedigree.
- **75-90%:** Medium-high accuracy. Some progeny information included. EBVs may change with addition of more progeny data.
- **more than 90%:** High accuracy estimate of the animal's true breeding value.

As a rule, animals should be compared on EBVs regardless of accuracy. However, where two animals have similar EBVs the one with higher accuracy could be the safer choice, assuming other factors are equal.

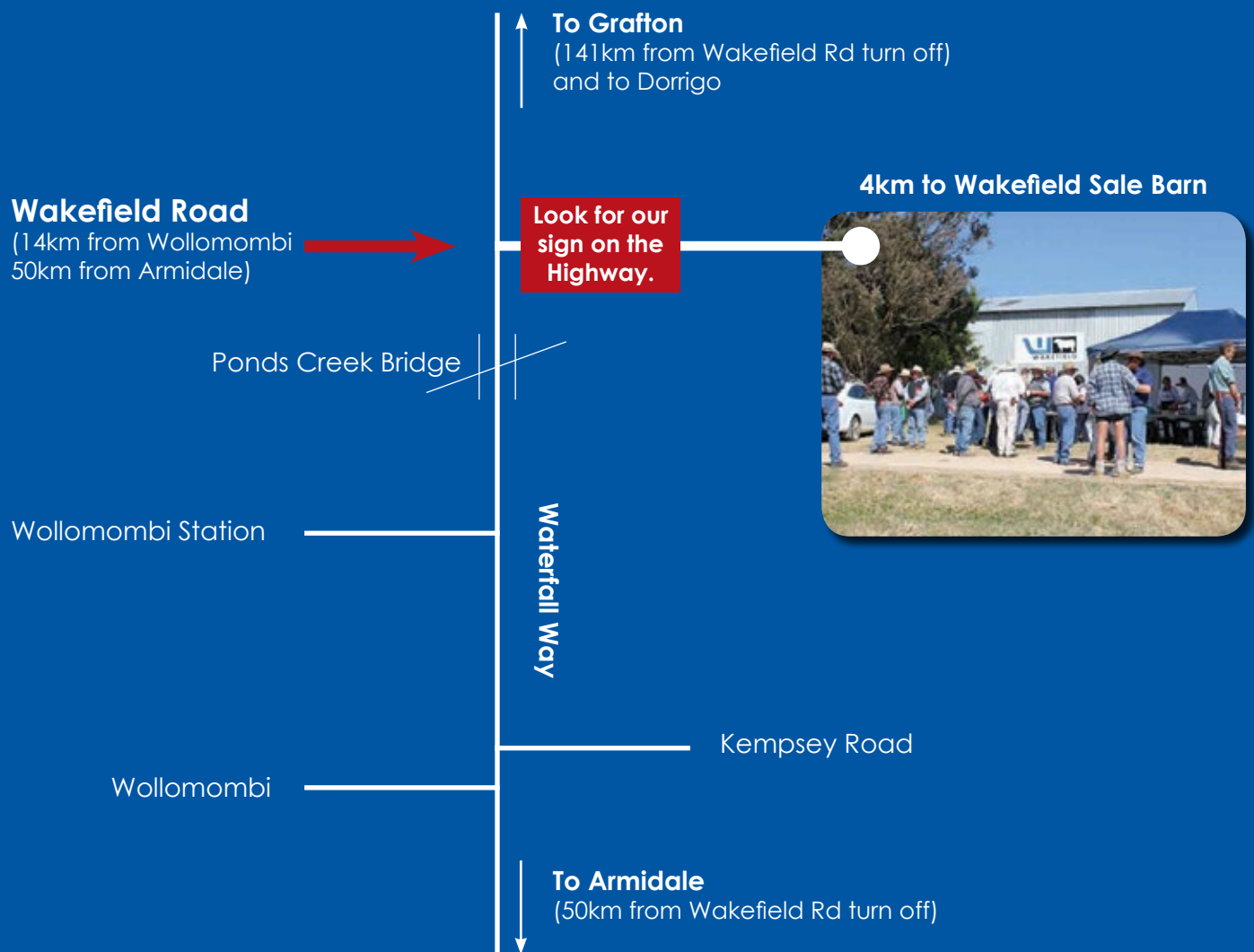
